Diving Center Colera, a family-owned business with over 20 years of experience dedicated to scuba diving and the exploration of the marine environment, aware of its location in a highly valuable area such as the **Cap de Creus Natural Park** and the future protection of the **Serra de l'Albera Natural Park**, is committed to conducting its activities based on the principles of sustainability and respect for the environment.

To achieve environmental excellence in our management, we commit to:

1. **Protection of the environment and pollution prevention**

- **Marine conservation:** Minimize the impact of our dives and snorkeling activities while raising our clients awareness of local flora and fauna.

We are committed to the active preservation of sensitive habitats, such as Posidonia meadows and coralligenous reefs, and to the selective collection of waste found during our dives.

2. **Responsible use of natural resources**

- We promote **the efficient use of water and energy**, optimizing the resources needed for our activities.
 - We implement measures to reduce water consumption through savings systems and by raising awareness among stakeholders about the importance of valuing this limited resource.
 - We apply energy-efficient technologies, such as using heat from boat engines to warm shower water and LED lighting throughout the center.

3. **Circular economy and waste management**

- **Lifecycle extension:** Extend the useful life of materials by encouraging reuse, donation, or specialized recycling to prevent them from becoming waste.
- **Strict control:** Ensure rigorous selective collection and safe storage of waste and chemicals to avoid any environmental incidents.
- **Green purchasing and supplier collaboration:** We work to improve the acquisition of products and services with lower environmental impact, promoting the use of durable materials and biodegradable cleaning products. We are committed to transferring our environmental values to our supply chain by evaluating and selecting suppliers that demonstrate an active commitment to sustainability.

4. **Legal compliance and other requirements**

- **Regulatory framework:** Comply with current environmental legislation, the regulations of the Natural Park and Marine Reserves where we operate, as well as voluntarily adopted commitments, such as the Biosphere certification.

5. **Continuous improvement and training**

- **Management system:** Maintain and continuously improve our **Environmental Management System (ISO 14001)** to enhance our environmental performance year after year.



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- **Training:** Educate and empower our team to act as conservation ambassadors and apply best environmental practices in every activity at the center.

- **Harmony with the territory:** We commit to ensuring maximum landscape integration of our facilities within the Cap de Creus Natural Park and the future Serra de l'Albera Natural Park, minimizing visual and environmental impact within the ecosystem in which the center is located.
